Applications Update for Program Year 2026

The Navigator Grant and CDO applications will be released in the upcoming weeks. Organizations will have until the end of July and September, respectfully to apply. Exact dates and more details will be shared via email, during upcoming meetings and in our newsletter. Both applications will be completed electronically this year. We welcome applications from returning Navigator Grantees or CDOs as well as new organizations for the upcoming PY 2026.

Reporting Compliance	Plan Advising Compliance	
Each Navigator Grantee must submit its monthly report on the 15th of each month on the form provided by Georgia Access as well as its quarterly report on the 15th of March, June, September, and December. Each CDO must submit its quarterly report on the 15th of March, June, September, and December using the form provided by Georgia Access. As we have informed in the past, the due dates were changed to the 15th of January, April, July, and October.	Assisters are prohibited from recommending, selling, soliciting or negotiating plans. If consumers know the exact plan they want to choose, the assister can help them in completing the enrollment process providing unbiased support.	As part of the Navigator Grantee and CDO program requirements, Navigators are expected to conduct, at least three events per month, while CACs are expected to conduct, at least one event per month.
